The Standards Commission for Scotland is committed to the promotion of high ethical standards in public life through the promotion and enforcement of Codes of Conduct for Councillors and Members of devolved public bodies.

The Parliamentary corporation is seeking to appoint, with the agreement of the Scottish Parliament, a new Commission member. With a time commitment of at least 24 days per annum you will be required to: review reports from the Commissioner for Ethical Standards in Public Life in Scotland and determine whether to hold a Hearing; promote the ethical standards framework through the issuing of guidance and training; and attend monthly meetings to ensure the effective running of the Commission.

In addition to having the ability to assimilate complex information to reach sound and impartial decisions you must also have high levels of integrity and excellent communication skills.

This appointment is for a fixed term of 6 years. The daily fee is £250.14 and the hourly rate for attending Hearings is £33.35

The Standards Commission is based in Edinburgh.
